Pastor's Message



My dear brothers and sisters:

It is not uncommon to hear the words apostle and disciple interchangeably. While both are in the same lexicon, they do not mean exactly the same thing. Today's

Gospel helps us to understand them and how they relate to our Christian identity.

Jesus, having previously called the Twelve and sent them out to preach and heal, is now sending seventy-two more disciples- again with the same message and task. So, what is the difference between the two? By definition, a disciple is one who learns from or follows: a student. It is the root of the word "discipline." Each of us,

by or baptism, is made a disciple of Christ.

An apostle, on the other hand, is one who is sent forth ...to preach and share the teachings of another with others. These two titles, or descriptions, are different and yet related ...for clearly, one must be a disciple before being an apostle. Otherwise, what would one have to share and preach? May the intercession of Our Blessed Mother help us to be a good disciples and good apostles.

Mensaje del parroco

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

No es raro escuchar las palabras discípulo y apóstol intercambiante. Si bien ambos son parte de nuestro léxico de fe, no significan exactamente lo mismo.

Hoy El evangelio nos ayuda a entenderlos y cómo se relacionan con nuestra identidad cristiana.

Jesús, habiendo llamado previamente a los Doce y enviado a predicar y sanar, ahora está enviando setenta y dos discípulos más, nuevamente con el mismo mensaje y tarea.

Entonces, ¿cuál es la diferencia entre los dos? Por definición, un discípulo es alguien que aprende o sigue: un estudiante. Es la raíz de la palabra

“disciplina”. Cada uno de nosotros,

por el bautismo, se hace discípulo de Cristo.

Un apóstol, por otro lado, es alguien que es enviado...a predicar y compartir las enseñanzas de otro con otros. Estos dos títulos, o descripciones, son diferentes y, sin embargo, están relacionados...

pues claramente, uno debe ser discípulo antes de ser apóstol. De lo contrario, ¿qué tendría uno para compartir y predicar? Que la intercesión de Nuestra Santísima Madre nos ayude a ser buenos discípulos y buenos apóstoles.
