Pastor's Message

My dear brothers and sisters:

In Jesus' time the tax collectors job was to enforce the tax imposed by the Roman occupiers. Tax collectors were known to overcharge and pocket the difference. They were perceived as greedy, dishonest, and more loyal to the Romans than to their own community and kin. Of course, we feel sympathy for the lowly and the oppressed; we understand why the Lord attends to the cries of orphans and widows.

But the tax collector? It is not so easy to feel sympathy toward him, or to understand why his prayer is heard. Yet Jesus challenges us with this parable and its conclusion: The tax collector went home justified.

The Lord hears the cry of the poor and the tax collector; but does he hear our prayers? The Lord knows no favorites, but he hears the cry of those who are humble enough to admit their need for him, their need for his mercy and redemption. He waits for you and for me.

God's Son humbled himself to be one with us, to teach us to be humble and to place ourselves in God's hands, as he did when he surrendered himself to the cross.

In the Eucharist, we recall his humility and seek the grace to be humble like him.

Se sabía que los recaudadores de impuestos cobraban de más y se embolsaban la diferencia. Eran percibidos como codiciosos, deshonestos y más leales a los romanos que a su propia comunidad y parientes. Por supuesto, sentimos simpatía por los humildes y los oprimidos; entendemos por qué el Señor atiende los gritos de los huérfanos y las viudas.

¿Pero el recaudador de impuestos? No es tan fácil sentir simpatía hacia él, o entender por qué Su oración fue escuchada.. Sin embargo, Jesús nos desafía con esta parábola y su conclusión: El recaudador de impuestos se fue a casa justificado.

El Señor escucha el clamor de los pobres y de publicano; Pero ¿Escucha nuestras oraciones? El Señor no conoce favoritos, pero escucha el clamor de aquellos que son lo suficientemente humildes como para admitir su necesidad de él, su necesidad de su misericordia y redención. Él te espera a ti y a mí.

El Hijo de Dios se humilló para ser uno con nosotros, para enseñarnos a ser humildes y a ponernos en las manos de Dios, como lo hizo cuando se entregó a la cruz.

En la Eucaristía, recordamos su humildad y buscamos la gracia de ser humildes como él.
