Pastor's Message

In this 27th Sunday Ordinary Time, God's Word invites us to consider Faith as gift from God. Therefore to understand today's Gospel and what prompted the disciples to ask for an increase in faith, it is useful to go back to the previous couple of chapters where Saint Luke tells three parable: the prodigal son, the dishonest steward, and Lazarus and the rich man. It can be difficult to be a faithful disciple today because our world is increasingly secular in outlook. Some attempt to silence the Gospel message and relegate faith to the realm of the private, where it can have no impact on the public square.

Christ's word to us today is a word of encouragement that we need only a little trust, the size of the mustard seed. It is the power of God living in and working through us that will ultimately allow us to be faith-filled as well as well as faithful.



Parish Membership and benefits
