Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In both the first reading and the Gospel, we hear about people who are thirsty. The

people in the desert cried out to Moses for water. Jesus asked the woman at the well for a drink.

While thirst is a natural part of our daily lives, in the Scriptures, it is sometimes used to speak to the longing in our spirits for union with God. Our bodies naturally hunger and thirst, but so do our souls.

Jesus uses his encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well to reveal to her that he is the only one who can satisfy the thirst that drives her. However, she ended up at that

place and has not found peace and fulfillment in her life. Jesus draws upon the

image of thirsting to share with her that he is the Messiah; if she becomes his disciple, she will never thirst again.

Today's Gospel calls us to drink from the well of Jesus' love. It is only in his love that we can quench our thirst and find our lives fulfilled.

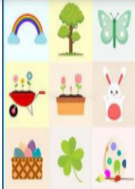

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

Tanto en la primera lectura como en el Evangelio. Oímos hablar de personas que tienen sed. la gente en el desierto clama a Moisés por agua. Jesús le pidió a la mujer en el pozo que le diera algo de beber. Si bien la sed es una parte natural de nuestra vida diaria, en las Escrituras lo es. a veces solía hablar del anhelo en nuestros espíritus de unión con Dios. Nuestros cuerpos tienen naturalmente hambre y sed, pero también lo hacen nuestras almas. Jesús usa su encuentro con la mujer samaritana en el pozo para darse cuenta de que él es el único que puede saciar la sed que la impulsa. Sin embargo, ella terminó en este lugar, ella claramente no ha encontrado paz y satisfacción en su vida.

Jesús recurre a la imagen de la sed de compartir con ella que él es el Mesías; si ella se convierte en su discípula, Ella nunca volverá a tener sed. Nuestro Evangelio de hoy nos llama a beber del pozo del amor de Jesús. Es sólo en su amor que podemos saciar nuestra sed y encontrar nuestras vidas satisfechas.
