Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

There's a lot to unpack in today's readings. At the center is Jesus' miraculous healing of a man born blind. He used tangible things (mud and spittle) in this miracle, just as we use tangible things (oil and water, for example) in the sacraments of the Church. Today, however, let's focus on the interaction between Jesus and the man born blind at the end of the Gospel after the man has regained his sight. What does Jesus do when he hears of the man's expulsion from the temple? Jesus goes to him. Jesus seeks him out and says, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" "The one speaking with you is he," and the man born blind worshipped him.

Friends, when any member of the body of Christ is hurt by another person, especially by a member of the Church, Jesus seeks out that member of his body. Jesus wants to find every lost or hurting sheep. If anyone has been hurt by a member of the Church or made to feel unwelcome or unloved, Jesus himself is seeking that person. Why? Because those types of behaviors are not of God. God is perfect. We humans are not, but Jesus knows our hearts, and he seeks out every single person, especially those most in need of healing. When he finds us sitting with our wounds or working through them, he comes with compassion. He asks us: Do you believe in the Son of Man? May he find each of us able to proclaim, "Yes, Lord, I believe."



Scripture Readings

First Reading: Then Samuel, with the horn of oil in hand, anointed David in the presence of his brothers; and from that day on, the spirit of the LORD rushed upon David. (1 Sm 16,13)

Second Reading: "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light." (Eph 5, 14)

Psalm: The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. (Ps 23)

Gospel: He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva, and smeared the clay on his eyes, and said to him, "Go wash in the Pool of Siloam" - which means Sent - . So he went and washed, and came back able to see. (Jn 9, 6-7)

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

Hay mucho que desempacar en las lecturas de hoy. En el centro está la curación milagrosa de Jesús de un ciego de nacimiento. Usó cosas tangibles (barro y saliva) en este milagro, tal como usamos cosas tangibles (aceite y agua, por ejemplo) en los sacramentos de la Iglesia. Hoy, sin embargo, centrémonos en la interacción entre Jesús y el hombre ciego de nacimiento en el final del Evangelio, después de que el hombre ha recobrado la vista. ¿Qué hace Jesús cuando se entera de la expulsión del hombre del templo? Jesús va a él Jesús lo busca y le dice: ¿Crees en el Hijo del Hombre? ...El que habla contigo es él. Y el ciego de nacimiento lo adoró. Amigos, cuando cualquier miembro del cuerpo de Cristo es herido por otra persona, y especialmente por un miembro de la Iglesia, Jesús busca a ese miembro de su cuerpo. Jesús quiere encontrar cada oveja perdida o herida. Si alguien ha sido herido por un miembro de la Iglesia o hecho sentir no bienvenido o no amado, Jesús mismo está buscando a esa persona. ¿Por qué? Porque ese tipo de comportamientos no son de Dios. Dios es perfecto. nosotros los humanos no lo somos, pero Jesús conoce nuestro corazón y busca a cada persona, especialmente los más necesitados de curación. Y cuando nos encuentra, sentados con nuestras heridas o trabajándolas, viene con compasión Nos pregunta: ¿Creéis en el Hijo del Hombre? Que encuentre cada uno de poder proclamar: "Sí, Señor, yo creo".
