## Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

On this third Sunday of Easter, we continue to celebrate in a more pronounced way the power and meaning of the Resurrection. Luke and Peter, whose words we hear today, were witnesses to the Resurrection and had interactions with the risen Christ. They were among the first to grapple with what it all meant and to share its good news.

We are recipients of that good news and come together in worship to be glad and rejoice in it. It was difficult for the disciples to understand all the events surrounding Jesus. Cleopas and his companion were debating all that had happened as they walked to Emmaus. It was not until a traveling companion interpreted Scripture for them and broke bread with them that they saw Jesus and comprehended how he had fulfilled the Scriptures. Peter tells us that fulfillment in Christ was known by God before the foundation of the world. Salvation through Christ's sacrificial love poured forth was always the plan.
