Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In today's Gospel, we see how Our Lord, Jesus, blesses those who believe even when they can't see what lies hidden beyond the veil of mystery. The Easter story is about people daring to believe in Jesus' resurrection precisely because they could not see or find his body in the tomb. No one saw the moment when the Lord God raised Jesus from the dead, but the Apostles would soon see Jesus, touch him, and eat with him by the shores of Galilee. He would give them the Holy Spirit to lead them in the crucial task that lay before them: establishing the church. He would also give them fortitude. There would be no looking back from that day forward. Some people look at a cross and see an interesting geometric shape, a piece of art, or a Roman symbol of torture. For the believer, when we look upon a cross, we see love and victory. When a worldly person sees an empty tomb, they also feel hollow. Witnesses to the Resurrection look at the empty tomb with hearts full of faith, and we believe precisely because of what we can't see inside of it: the body of Jesus. As we begin our 50-day celebration of Jesus' resurrection, may we be blessed for all that we do not see but still believe.



Scripture Readings

First Reading: This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. (Acts 10:40-41)

Second Reading: This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. (Ps 118)

Psalm: If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. (Col 3:1)

Gospel: For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead. (Jn 20: 9)

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos cómo Nuestro Señor, Jesús, bendice a los que creen incluso cuando No pueden ver lo que se esconde más allá del velo del misterio. La historia de Pascua es sobre personas que se atreven a creer en la resurrección de Jesús precisamente por lo que no pudieron Ver o encontrar, su cuerpo en la tumba. Nadie vio el momento en que el Señor Dios resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos, pero los apóstoles pronto verían a Jesús, tócarlo, y comer con él a orillas de Galilea. Serían fortalecidos por él y dados el Espíritu Santo para guiarlos en la importante obra que tenían por delante, la de construir la Iglesia. No habría Mirado hacia atrás desde ese día en adelante. Algunas personas miran una cruz y ven una forma geométrica interesante, una obra de arte o un símbolo romano de tortura. Para el creyente, cuando miramos una cruz vemos amor y victoria. Las personas mundanas miran una tumba vacía y se sienten así, vacías. Los testigos de la Resurrección miran la tumba vacía con corazones llenos de fe, y nosotros creemos precisamente por lo que no podemos ver dentro de él, el cuerpo de Jesús. Al comenzar nuestra celebración de 50 días de la resurrección de Jesús, que seamos bendecidos por todo lo que no vemos y todavía creemos.
