Dear Parishioners:

I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. With these words, our Lord makes it clear that he is the only redeemer of the world. Through his life, death, and resurrection, Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, has defeated for us the snares of sin and death and brought us back to the Father. Our faith teaches that Jesus redeemed the world that he came to heal and save all of humanity. Therefore, we should desire what he does. That is, it is our mission to continue what he began by preaching the Gospel to the world. These realities should challenge us to do two things: to commit ourselves to sharing the gospel of Jesus with others, and to pray for the work of missionaries and preachers around the world. We know that Jesus is the king of heaven, and to live in the joy of heaven we must submit ourselves to the Lordship of Jesus. We must work and pray to help all people find Jesus present now in the Eucharist, and to be united to him forever in heaven.
