Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, "Corpus Christi." It is a celebration of God's saving grace given to us in his word, promise, and hope for eternal life, all in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus, who gives us his body and blood in the Eucharist, is the perfect satisfaction of all desires and all hunger. He is the satisfaction of hunger for one's life to have meaning, to have forgiveness, and to have acceptance. These are some of our deepest spiritual hungers. They ultimately point to our hunger for God. This hunger can only be satisfied by spiritual "food." The food that is as Jesus says in the Gospel: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. What a blessing the Church provides us with many opportunities to be fed by Jesus. We are fed through the love we share with one another, through our shared acts of service and justice, through our shared prayer, and especially through our sharing of the Eucharist. Let us give thanks for these gifts.
