Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

During his life, Jeremiah experienced terrible hardships, including arrest, imprisonment, disgrace, and exile. He had reason to lose hope, but he kept his faith in God. The Lord is with me, like a mighty champion, he says. Sing to the Lord; praise the Lord, for he has rescued the lives of the poor from the power of the wicked! This lesson, however, is not just for prophets and martyrs. Every moment of our lives is an opportunity to acknowledge or deny Christ before others. C. S. Lewis writes: "Every time you make a choice, you're turning the central part of you, the part of you that chooses, into something a little different than it was before. And taking your life as a whole, with all your innumerable choices, all your life long you are slowly turning this central thing into a heavenly creature or a hellish creature." (Mere Christianity). Each choice we make will be know at the end of time. Our heavenly Father already knows our every thought and deed. Each choice can lead us closer to heaven or closer to hell. This should change how we view our daily lives. Some days we will face hardships, but we can choose to keep faith in God and sing his praises along with Jeremiah: The Lord is with me. Truly, the Lord is with us even now in the Eucharist. Lord, help us to realize that our Father, who loves us, will grant us the graces we need. Holy Spirit, help guide us. Give us the long view of eternity, knowing that our choices today will affect our souls for eternity. Lord, lead us to everlasting life with you.

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

Durante su vida, Jeremiah experimentó terribles privaciones, incluyendo arresto, encarcelamiento, deshonor y destierro. Tenía motivos para perder la esperanza, pero mantuvo su fe en Dios. El Señor está conmigo, como un poderoso campeón, dice. Cantad al Señor, alabad al Señor, ¡porque ha rescatado la vida de los pobres del poder de los impíos! Esta lección, sin embargo, no es solo para profetas y mártires. Cada momento de nuestras vidas es una oportunidad para reconocer o negar a Cristo ante los demás. C. S. Lewis escribe: “Cada vez que haces una elección, estás girando la parte central de ti, la parte de ti que elige, en algo un poco diferente de lo que era antes. Y tomando tu vida como un completo, con todas tus innumerables elecciones, durante toda tu vida estás convirtiendo lentamente esta cosa central en una criatura celestial o una criatura infernal”. (Mero cristianismo). Cada elección que hicimos saber al final de los tiempos. Nuestro Padre celestial ya lo sabe cada uno de nuestros pensamientos y acciones. Cada elección puede llevarnos más cerca del cielo o más cerca del infierno. Esto debería cambiar la forma en que vemos nuestra vida diaria. Algunos días enfrentaremos dificultades. Pero podemos optar por mantener la fe en Dios, y cantar sus alabanzas junto con Jeremías: El Señor está conmigo. En verdad, el Señor está con nosotros incluso ahora en la Eucaristía. Señor, ayúdanos a darnos cuenta de que nuestro Padre que nos ama nos concederá las gracias que necesitamos. Espíritu Santo, ayúdanos a guiarnos. Danos la visión a largo plazo de la eternidad, sabiendo que nuestras elecciones hoy afectará nuestras almas por la eternidad. Señor, llévanos a la vida eterna contigo.
