Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

Have you ever asked yourself: How is it that I have received the gift of faith, faith in God and faith in Jesus Christ? And how do I practice the Faith as part of the Catholic Church? Think about this for a minute. Is it just circumstance, or is it the will of God that you have embraced this gift? Have you ever watched a seed grow? Do you remember that childhood educational activity, where a seed is placed in a clear bag and taped to a window so everyone can marvel at it breaking open and bursting forth with new life? This powerful image runs through our readings today: God's creative power poured out to bring forth fruit, nourishment, and life. And this is the image Jesus offers us for the creative work he wants to do in our lives. In these readings, God is both sower and seed, the one who gives water and light, the one who calls forth growth, and the one who yields great fruit. Our God speaks. But, for the most part, God does not yell. We are given true freedom, as well as responsibility, to hear and to see. If we are to bear fruit, we must choose to receive his Divine Grace. We must choose silence, we must choose to avoid distractions, and we must choose to be attentively present.



Today, may we all be nourished for the profound and vital work of you and I seeing and hearing God's word. May the Eucharist draw us to wonder and attentiveness. May God call us in each Mass to enter into the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven and send us forth to bear great fruit for his kingdom.

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

¿Te has preguntado alguna vez: cómo es que he recibido el don de la fe, la fe en Dios y la fe en Jesucristo? ¿Y cómo es que practico la Fe como parte de la Iglesia Católica? Piensa en esto por un minuto. ¿Son solo las circunstancias o es el voluntad de Dios que hayas acogido este don. ¿Alguna vez has visto crecer una semilla? ¿Recuerdas esa actividad educativa infantil, donde se coloca una semilla en una bolsa transparente y se pega con cinta adhesiva a una ventana para que todos puedan maravillarse al abrirse y brotar una nueva vida? Esta poderosa imagen recorre nuestras lecturas de hoy: el poder creador de Dios, derramado para producir fruto, alimento y vida. Y esta es la imagen que Jesús nos ofrece para el trabajo creativo que quiere hacer en nuestras vidas individuales. En estas lecturas, Dios es a la vez sembrador y semilla, el que da agua y luz, el que suscita el crecimiento y el que da gran fruto. Nuestro Dios habla. Pero, en su mayor parte, Dios no grita. Se nos da verdadera libertad, así como responsabilidad, para oír y ver. Si vamos a dar fruto, debemos hacer la elección de recibir esta gracia, su Divina Gracia. Debemos elegir el silencio, debemos elegir evitar las distracciones, debemos elegir estar presentes atentamente. Hoy, que todos seamos nutridos por el trabajo profundo y vital de ustedes y yo viendo y escuchando la palabra de Dios. Que la Eucaristía nos lleve al asombro ya la atención. Que Dios nos llame en cada Misa a entrar en los misterios del reino de los cielos y nos envíe a dar grandes frutos para su reino.
