#### Pastor's Message

#### Dear Parishioners:

When learning a new sport, it is vital to know the rules. Baseball players cannot kick the ball, but they can throw it with their hands; soccer players cannot touch the ball with their hands, but they can use their feet to kick it. Football players cannot cross the line of scrimmage until play begins,



but they can move in certain directions beforehand. The rules are helpful, keeping athletes in line so the game can run smoothly, objectives can be met, and goals can be achieved. Each of us has our own Christian "athletic" adventure of "running the race toward the prize of the eternal crown," as Saint Paul often analogizes. This is a lifelong route along a path of moral living, striving for holiness. Jesus and Paul both knew that a healthy spirituality could not be maintained by the mere avoidance of sin. God is offering us so much more, namely the pursuit of virtue and the abundant life that comes through love.
