Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

There are two ways to play dominoes. One is to divide the tiles and start with one in the middle. Players take turns matching up tiles, adding to the growing configuration. Another way is to stand the dominoes up in a row, then tip the first to cause them to fall, one by one, in a chain reaction. It is captivating to watch them fall in a wave, especially when there are curves and loops. However, if they are not lined up just right or if there are gaps, the chain reaction stops, and the rest will not fall. Stopping a chain reaction of mercy is what the debtor does in today's Gospel. Jesus' parable illustrates the Old Testament wisdom of Sirach. How can we expect pardon and healing for ourselves, yet nourish vengeance and refuse mercy to others? In the community of God's covenant, mercy is shared. Like the intricate configuration of a domino game, God's mercy touches and connects us all. No one lives or dies for oneself; we are the Lord's, redeemer together in his mercy and love. We celebrate this in his live presence in the Eucharist, the memorial of his great love and mercy.



Scripture Readings

First Reading: Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven. (Sir 28,2)

Psalm: The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger, and rich in compassion. (Ps 103)

Second Reading: None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's. (Rom 14,7-8)

Gospel: Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times." (Mt 18,21-22)

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

Hay dos formas de jugar al dominó. Una es dividir las fichas y comenzar con una en la mitad. Los jugadores se turnan para unir fichas, lo que aumenta la configuración en crecimiento. Otra forma es colocar las fichas de dominó en fila y luego inclinar la primera para que caigan, una por una, en una reacción en cadena. Es fascinante verlos caer en una ola, especialmente si hay curvas y vueltas. Pero si no se viven adecuadamente, o si hay lagunas, la reacción en cadena se detiene y el resto no caerá. Detener una reacción en cadena de misericordia es lo que hace el deudor en la parábola del Evangelio de hoy. La parábola de Jesús ilustra la sabiduría de Sirac en el Antiguo Testamento. ¿Cómo podemos esperar perdón y curación para nosotros mismos y, al mismo tiempo, alimentar la venganza y negarnos la misericordia a los demás? En la comunidad de la alianza de Dios, la misericordia se comparte. como lo intrincado para la Configuración de un juego de dominó. La misericordia de Dios nos toca y nos conecta a todos. Nadie vive ni muere para sí mismo; somos del Señor, redentores juntos en su misericordia y amor. Lo celebramos en su presencia viva en la Eucaristía, memorial de su gran amor y misericordia.
