Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

Everyone loves a feast, and that was as true in ancient times as it is now. It is not surprising, then, that biblical writers use feasting imagery to give us a sense of God's overabundant generosity: a feast of rich food and choice wines; you spread the table before me; a weeing feast for a son. The prophet Isaiah sets God's feast of rich food and pure, choice wines on Mount Zion,

the location of Jerusalem and the temple, and the audience would know that offerings to God at the temple were conceived as a banquet with God. But Isaiah quickly moves on from the material imagery of food and drink to the even greater riches that God will provide: unity among all people, eternal life, joy salvation, and most importantly, God's very presence. The hand of the Lord will rest on this mountain. In a homily in 2021, Pope Francis assured us: "The Eucharist is not the reward of saints; no, it is the bread of sinners." May we now come together to this greatest of feasts at Christ's table, accepting the invitation to share in God's lavish abundance so we may go out and lavishly share it with all.

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

A todo el mundo le encantan las fiestas, y eso era tan cierto en la antigüedad como lo es ahora. Es sorprendente, entonces, que los escritores bíblicos utilicen imágenes de banquetes para darnos una idea de la presencia de Dios. generosidad sobreabundante: un festín de rica comida y vinos selectos; serviste la mesa delante de mí; un banquete para un hijo. El profeta Isaías establece el banquete de Dios de rica comida y vinos puros y selectos en el monte Sión, la ubicación de Jerusalén y el templo, y la audiencia sabría que las ofrendas a Dios en el templo fueron concebidas como un banquete con Dios. Pero Isaías rápidamente pasa de las imágenes materiales de comida y bebida a riquezas aún mayores que Dios proporcionará: unidad entre todos los pueblos, vida eterna, alegría, salvación y, lo más importante, la presencia misma de Dios. La mano del Señor descansará sobre este monte. En una homilía de 2021, el Papa Francisco nos aseguró: "La Eucaristía no es la recompensa de los santos, no, es el pan de los pecadores". Que ahora nos reunamos en la más grande de las fiestas en la mesa de Cristo, aceptando la invitación de compartir la abundancia de Dios para que podamos salir y compartirla generosamente con todos.
