Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

As we approach the end of the liturgical year, our readings focus on the end times. In St. Paul's Letter to the Thessalonians, he tells them that the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night- unseen and unannounced. Or it will be like labor pains upon a pregnant woman- sudden and bringing risk. We may not know the exact hour of the Lord's return, but it is expected and inescapable. Therefore, we must be prepared. Today's Gospel, gives us a little more information about what to expect upon Jesus' return. In the story, the master distributes his possessions to his servants according to their abilities. The talents in the story are coins, but we know that God gives all kinds of gifts, both temporal and spiritual. Everything he gives, he expects us to use. The fact that gifts are not distributed equally encourages us to share them. Not only are we invited to share what we have, but also to acknowledge what we lack, recognizing that we need the gifts of others. Each of us was created to live in a community of mutual giving and receiving, modeled on the Trinity. We can use only the gifts we have been given, but if we use them as God intends, he will multiply them. If, on the other hand, we sit idle or ignore them, their benefits will be taken from us. The ultimate benefit, the final payout for a life of good and faithful service, is eternal joy with God.



Scripture Readings

First Reading: She brings him good, and not evil, all the days of her life. She obtains wool and flax and works with loving hands. (Prv 31,12-13)

Psalm: Blessed are those who fear the Lord. (Ps 128)

Second Reading: But you, brothers and sisters, are not in darkness, for that day to overtake you like a thief. For all of you are children of the light and children of the day. (1 Thes 5,4-5)

Gospel: "Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy." (Mt 25,21)

A medida que nos acercamos al final del año litúrgico, nuestras lecturas se centran en el fin de los tiempos. en Carta de San Pablo a los Tesalonicenses, les dice que llegará el día del Señor como un ladrón de noche, sin ser visto y sin previo aviso. O serán como dolores de parto en una mujer embarazada- Riesgo repentino y trascendente. Es posible que no sepamos la hora exacta del el regreso del Señor, pero es esperado e ineludible. Por tanto, debemos estar preparados. El Evangelio de hoy nos da un poco más de información sobre qué esperar al regreso de Jesús. En la historia, el amo distribuye sus bienes a sus sirvientes de acuerdo con sus habilidades. Los talentos en la historia son monedas, pero sabemos que Dios da todo tipos de dones, tanto temporales como espirituales. Todo lo que él da, espera que lo usemos. El hecho de que los regalos no se distribuyan equitativamente nos anima a compartirlos. No solo Estamos invitados a compartir lo que tenemos, pero también a reconocer lo que nos falta, reconocer que necesitamos los dones de los demás.
