Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In the first reading, Ezekiel uses the image of a cedar tree planted at the top of a mountain to prophesy that God will restore Israel under a new king from the line of David. We know that Jesus is this new king, the long-awaited Messiah of Israel. But his kingdom is not the political dynasty the people hoped for. Jesus came to proclaim the kingdom of God. Where are we in these readings? Somewhere between the planting and the harvest. The kingdom of God is already here. But we also know that Christ will come again. As Paul writes in the second reading, *we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ*. Until then, we walk by faith, knowing that what God has in store for us is greater than anything we could imagine. The work of the present is to build the kingdom of God, trusting that he will provide for its growth, even we cannot see it. We are called to do good and avoid doing evil so we will be ready when harvest time comes.



Scripture Readings

First Reading: "Thus says the Lord GOD: I, too, will take from the crest of the cedar, from its topmost branches tear off a tender shoot, and plant it on a high and lofty mountain; on the mountain heights of Israel I will plant it. It shall put forth branches and bear fruit, and become a majestic cedar...." (Ez 17:22-24)

Psalms: "Lord, it is good to give thanks to you." (Ps 92:2-3, 13-14, 15-16)

Second Reading: Brothers and sisters: We are always courageous, although we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, for we walk by faith, not by sight. Yet we are courageous, and we would rather leave the body and go home to the Lord. (2 Cor 5:6-10)

Gospel: "Jesus said to the crowds: "This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. " ... (Mk 4:26-34)
