Scripture Readings

First Reading: The Lord GOD opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting. The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame. He is near who upholds my right; if anyone wishes to oppose me, let us appear together. Who disputes my right? Let that man confront me. See, the Lord GOD is my help; who will prove me wrong? ([Is 50:5-9a](#))

Psalm: I will walk before the Lord, in the land of the living. ([Ps 116:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 8-9](#))

Second Reading: What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well," but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it? So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead. Indeed someone might say, "You have faith and I have works." Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works. ([Jas 2:14-18](#))

Gospel: Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ." Then he warned them not to tell anyone about him. He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him." ... ([Mk 8:27-35](#))

Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners:

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks his disciples what other people are saying about him. Then he asks them: Who do you say that I am? When Peter answers that he is the Christ, Jesus warns his disciple not to tell anyone about him. There are certainly practical reasons for this instruction. If the disciples had begun preaching that Jesus was the Messiah, it likely would have angered the Roman and Jewish officials. We should ask ourselves who we say Jesus is and what it means for us to follow him. How do our ideas about suffering fit into this picture? Today's first reading from the prophet Isaiah assures us that when we suffer with Christ, and especially when we endure suffering for Christ, God is with us. The Lord God is our help. If we persevere in following Christ's way, the way of the cross, we will not be put to shame. If we lose our life for Christ's sake and that of the Gospel, we will be saved.

Mensaje del parroco

Estimados feligreses:

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús pregunta a sus discípulos qué dicen otras personas de él. Luego les pregunta: ¿Quién dicen ustedes que soy yo? Cuando Pedro responde que él es el Cristo, Jesús advierte a su discípulo que no le hable a nadie de él. Hay razones prácticas para esta instrucción. Si los discípulos hubieran comenzado a predicar que Jesús era el Mesías, probablemente habrían enfadado a los funcionarios romanos y judíos. Deberíamos preguntarnos quién decimos que es Jesús y qué significa para nosotros seguirlo. ¿Cómo encajan nuestras ideas sobre el sufrimiento en este cuadro? La primera lectura de hoy del profeta Isaías nos asegura que cuando sufrimos con Cristo, y especialmente cuando soportamos el sufrimiento por Cristo, Dios está con nosotros. El Señor Dios es nuestra ayuda. Si perseveramos en seguir el camino de Cristo, el camino de la cruz, no seremos avergonzados. Si perdemos nuestra vida por causa de Cristo y la del Evangelio, seremos salvados.
